PEER SUPPORT SERVICES



Peer & Family Support Services are offered to adolescents, adults and their families. Focusing on individuals with intellectual and developmental disabilities, service delivery may include in-person or telehealth support approximately three hours per week for up to three months. Peer Mentoring (one-on-one) is offered to encourage, motivate, and support beneficiaries moving forward in:
